<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Must be a United States Citizen</li> <li>2. Be 21 years of age</li> <li>3. Be a qualified voter</li> <li>4. Be a registered voter in the Ward you are seeking election in as of January 15, 2025</li> <li>5. Resided continuously in the Ward for which you are seeking election for 12 months prior to the first allowed filing date for the election</li> <li>6. Not been determined mentally incompetent by a final judgement of a court</li> <li>7. Not been finally convicted of a felony from which you have not been pardoned or otherwise released.</li> </ol>	First day to file is Wednesday, January 15, 2025  Last day to file is Friday, February 14, 2025

NOTICE AND RECORD OF MEETING OF POLITICAL SUBDIVISION’S GOVERNING BODY		
Section 5512 of the Government Code provides that every regular, special or called meetings of a governmental body shall be open to the public. Section 551.031 provides that notices must adhere to the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be posted at least 72 hours prior to the scheduled time of the meeting</li> <li>• Be in writing and clearly state the date, hour, place and subject of each meeting</li> <li>• Be posted in two locations                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ On a bulletin board convenient to the public at City Hall, located at 200 W.
