4. Discussion and Presentation on Brenham Police Department Statistics for April and May 2024

Interim Chief Powell presented the April and May patrol and performance statistics for the Brenham Police Department.

5. Discussion and Presentation on the Brenham Police Department's Mission Statement

Interim Chief Powell discussed the intent to update the Brenham Police Department's Mission Statement. Powell explained that with a new command staff, this will be a good opportunity to redefine the culture, values and identity of the department.

The current mission statement is as follows:

“The mission of the Brenham Police Department is to proudly serve the community by protecting our citizens, enforcing the law, and working in partnership with the public to enhance the quality of life by holding ourselves to the highest standards of performance and ethics.”

Powell requested that the Board provide suggestions for the new statement.

6. Administrative Updates

Interim Chief Powell, Lt. Raven and Lt. Schoen provided brief updates on administrative issues such as personnel changes, current and upcoming staff training and the status of the cadets attending the Bryan Academy.

One of the cadet's representing BPD has withdrawn from attending the Bryan Academy.

Powell stated that July 11th will be the date of his official promotion to Chief. This will take place at the City Council meeting. After Powell is named Chief, he will then officially name Lt. Schoen as Assistant Chief. Due to Schoen's position being vacated, there will be testing and interviews for both Lieutenant and Sergeant positions. Only someone in a Sergeant position can apply for a Lieutenant position, which would leave an opening for a Sergeant position, therefore creating the need for Sergeant testing. The testing and interviews will take place in early August.

Staff liaison Christi Korth announced the next CAB meeting will take place August 13, 2024.
