4. Discussion and Presentation on Brenham Police Department Statistics for July 2024

Chief Powell presented the July patrol and performance statistics for the Brenham Police Department. Powell explained the newly implemented HEAT (Highway Enforcement and Traffic) Unit. The Unit consists of a shift of officers that will target a specific area running traffic. The target location will change each time the Unit is deployed.

5. Discussion and Presentation on the Brenham Police Department's Drone Program

Asst. Chief Schoen introduced the current drone used by the department. Schoen demonstrated how the drone if maneuvered and gave examples of the various uses of the drone. He explained that Brenham PD will go before Council next month with the request to purchase two drones. One of the drones has night vision and other has thermal vision.

6. Administrative Updates

Chief Powell, Asst. Chief Schoen and Lt. Raven provided brief updates on administrative issues such as personnel changes, current and upcoming staff training and the status of the cadet attending the Bryan Academy.

Lt. Raven talked about recruiting and the newly adjusted pay scale for officers. There was a recent pay scale increase so the department can be competitive for new hires. Long term/tenured employees will receive a one-time retention payment. Lt. Raven will be starting to aggressively search for potential new hires. A recruitment video is in the works.

Staff liaison Christi Korth announced the next CAB meeting will take place October 8, 2024.
