- All City staff members received new cyber security training by AmTrust Cyber on December 3 to keep city staff current with new issues and information. Library staff is discussing library card policy and procedures to keep our patron accounts secure.
- The Library is implementing several new ideas to help our patrons. We now have the New York Times bestsellers list posted with the included books labeled and displayed. We are also updating some of the series book spine labels to display the series order. Yearly collection weeding is in progress.
- Job assignments, tasks, procedures, and forms are being clarified.

Programs	<ul> <li>In addition to our regular monthly programs, the library presented Story Night with Santa on December 9, 2024 with more than 100 participants.</li> <li>The Dolly Parton Imagination Program has grown to 107 participants. The estimated cost per child has increased to \$27 a year. We had a \$713 donation to DPIL made December 4, 2024, with another pending.</li> <li>Our Food for Fines food drive collected 450 food items from the patrons. Several patrons who did not have fines to be forgiven donated for others, in the spirit of paying it forward. Food items were donated to the Food for Families Food Drive on December 4, 2024.</li> <li>Betty Thiel hosted a Christmas potluck party on December 14 with the Sew Sew Sewing participants trading sewing material squares.</li> <li>Lou-Lou Barbour will have a story time at the Brenham Bus Depot Museum in collaboration with the Brenham Heritage Museum on December 23 at 11:30am.</li> <li>Audrey Lack will host Anime Trivia: Jeopardy Style on December 26.</li> </ul>
