Re: Discussion and Update of Brenham Family Park Notice to Proceed from Texas Parks and Wildlife

As you all know it has been a long-awaited period for the City of Brenham to get the notice to proceed on the Brenham Family Park Project. We now have the contract in our hands to sign and are ready to make this a reality for Brenham.

Over the last 3 years, while we were waiting on clearance from Texas Parks and Wildlife and the National Parks Service, we began design of Phase 1 in order to meet our grant elements as it pertains to the amenities that will go into the park. We also earmarked additional funds through BCDC (sales tax revenues) knowing that \$750,000 would not go far when you consider an amenity/retention pond, parking, signage, utility extensions, a restroom facility, 1-mile walking/biking trail, lighting, benches, pedestrian bridge, and wildflower areas. During that time BCDC has allocated an additional \$1,015,148 to help get this project started and off the ground. This brings the total available funds to \$1,765,148 to get started for Phase 1.

Action Items Moving Forward

We will be presenting this item to City Council in January for authorization to move forward with the \$750,000 grant from Texas Parks and Wildlife. We will then work with Quiddity Engineering to meet the grant elements yet give the City some options to consider when it deals with the current funds allocated toward this project. The contract states that the project needs to be completed by May of 2027. TP&W also allows the recipient to extend projects up to an additional 2 years to meet final construction.

We will work strategically with Quiddity as we prepare the bid in Spring of 2025. We will also reference the Facility Naming Rights Policy as we move throughout this project. If there is any interest from the public or any members of the

MINUTES

CITY OF BRENHAM PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

September 11, 2024

A regular meeting of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was held on Wednesday, September 11, 2024, beginning at noon at Brenham City Hall – Conference Room 2-A, 200 W. Vulcan Street, Brenham, Texas. Due to the number of visitors, we moved the meeting down to the City Council Chambers.

2. Citizen/Visitor Comments

No comments outside of the agenda items were discussed.

WORK SESSION

3. Discussion and Review of 90% Plans Associated with Jackson Street Park Improvements (Burditt Consultants LLC)

Public Works Director Dane Rau started this discussion. The City of Brenham Parks and Recreation staff has been working with Burditt Consultants LLC to make upgrades to Jackson Street Park. There has been a total of \$1.2 million dollars directed to upgrade amenities at this park which comes directly from the Brenham Community Development Corporation and 401B sales tax revenues. Of that \$1.2 million dollars about \$1 million can be directly related to new amenities or new construction.

We started with a Master Plan and have now worked through the major amenities and today, Burditt explained those as well as went over the estimated costs associated with the desired amenities.

The main focus in this first phase is to improve the park as it relates to ADA Standards, replacement of old play equipment, overhaul of the electrical throughout the park which will improve the field lighting, trail lighting, parking lot lighting and low-level lighting as well as a new restroom facility.

Burditt Consultants LLC gave a presentation to the board and those in attendance to walk through the new amenities and what can be addressed with the allocated funds.

There is hope that a Phase 2 could occur in the upcoming years to address some other amenities that are not included in Phase 1 such as additional pickleball courts, an open-air pavilion, and more connectivity in the middle of the park.

We encourage the board to ask questions as well as citizens attending the meeting. Our goal is to bid out this project in late October and start construction in late 2024 or early 2025.

Cindy asked about lighting and additional trees on the Rail Road Side of the track along with drainage issues around the bridge. Director Dane Rau asked about restrooms and two options to build offsite and bring and drop in place similar to the one at the splashpad. Board Member Lee Chalmers asked about doing a remodel for now to spruce it up but not spend that extra money on it. Board Member Trisha Hartstack asked if there was a need for additional toilets or if a remodel would be sufficient. Harvey McIntyre asked about the issue of cost and what was more effective. Lisa stated that she felt the community need currently was more pickleball courts as the current ones need some update and there are more and more people using the courts the youth in our community, Blinn College and Brenham High School students are using so she feels more courts would and should be in the first phase. It was also suggested that if possible, we put a backboard somewhere near the pickleball courts (maybe that is the restrooms) to use for single players... this could be a mural and an added feature to the park but would be used by several.

Per Chapter 19, Parks and Recreation, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Brenham fees for all parks and recreation activities shall be set by resolution of the City Council. Each year rates are evaluated and brought to Parks Board for consideration.

At the July 10, 2024, meeting, Parks Board & staff discussed the option of Adult Soccer League using fields and what this might look like regarding usage and fees. Recommendations included a \$20/player fee for Adult Extended League Soccer Fee.

Below is the recommended changes for 2025.
