## **OUTDOOR BURNING OVERVIEW**

The Brenham Fire Department receives numerous calls regarding *open burning*. This document explains the Open Burning Regulations as approved by Chapter 11, Section 11-23 Burning Refuse of the City of Brenham Code of Ordinances. Failure to follow good safety practices with fire can lead to serious injuries and property damage.

Extinguishment Authority – The fire code official is authorized to order the extinguishment of any open burning, recreational fire, or bonfire that creates offensive/objectionable smoke or odor or adds to a hazardous or objectionable situation.

- should NOT be conducted within 300-ft. of a structure or combustible material and piled no higher than 8-ft. and no wider than 12ft.
- may be subject to enforcement of other City Codes such as, but not limited to, the Nuisance Code

Attendance is required, at all times, until the fire is extinguished. Also required - and available for immediate use, if needed - is a *minimum* of one portable fire extinguisher or other approved on-site fire extinguishing equipment (i.e., dirt, sand, water, barrel, garden hose, water truck).
