



#### K-9 Officer Retires

On September 17, 2020 it was official, K-9 Officer Robbie retires after 4 years of loyal and productive service to the Brenham Police Department and the citizens of our community. That day at City Hall, Robbie and his handler Officer Andy Adams were center stage as Mayor Milton Tate proclaimed September 17th, 2020 as K-9 Officer Robbie Day in Brenham. On hand were city officials the Police Chief and many members of the Police Department.

Robbie, a female Belgian Malinois, joined the BPD in November of 2016 thanks to a donation by a private individual and member of our Citizens on Patrol group. In her career, Robbie was deployed some 525 times which resulted in 205 arrests. Robbie and her handler, Officer Adams conducted building searches, searched vehicles for narcotics, searched for missing persons and assisted in issuing warrants. Robbie and Andy also conducted numerous public demonstrations of their skills at schools, churches and other organizational events; but, first and foremost, Robbie was a working dog. Chief Parker said, "they have been a great asset to our community." The Chief further stated, "for now, we are going to put the K-9 program on hold and reevaluate the program. Robbie has been a great asset and we appreciate her and Andy for their dedication." Now, upon her retirement, Robbie will remain with Andy and his family where she will get to enjoy her time as a stay-at-home family pet and get to play with kids all day. Officer Adams will miss his partner while on patrol, but will see her every day at the end of his shift. Congratulations to K-9 Officer Robbie on a well-deserved retirement; she will be living her best life!






