

***FUTURE ELECTION DATES***

The City of Brenham General Elections are held every four (4) years, in odd numbered years, on the first Saturday in May. Below is a schedule of upcoming elections:

  - Place 5 – At Large
  - Place 6 – At Large

- Saturday, May 3, 2031
  - Mayor
  - Place 2 – Ward 2

- Saturday, May 7, 2033
  - Place 1 – Ward 1
  - Place 3 – Ward 3
  - Place 5 – At Large
  - Place 6 – At Large

***WARDS***

The City of Brenham is divided into four (4) wards. There is one Councilmember elected in each Ward to represent residents of that Ward.

Ward 1  
Ward 3

Ward 2  
Ward 4

The Councilmembers representing Place 5 – At Large and Place 6 – At Large are elected City-wide and represent all residents of the City of Brenham.

## ***QUALIFICATIONS***

All candidates for City Council must meet the following qualifications:

- Be a U. S. citizen;
- Have been a resident of the City, and any Ward they are wishing to represent, for a period of 12 months immediately preceding the election;
- Be at least 21 years of age, when elected;
- Not be indebted to the City; and
- Not be interested in the sale to the City of any supplies, equipment, materials, or articles.

Candidates can file their application for a place on the ballot during the applicable filing period in the Office of the City Secretary, located at 200W. Vulcan Street, Brenham, TX 77833.

There are no filing fees to file for a place on the ballot.
