### 4. Discussion and Presentation on Brenham Police Department Recruitment Video

Lt. Raven presented the recruitment video that was recently created for the department. Raven thanked everyone involved in the making of the video. Chief Powell stated that he is extremely proud of the new video. It was noted that BPD staff member Brandy Testa was the person who spearheaded the project.

5. **Discussion and Presentation on the Brenham Police Department's Statistics for August 2024**Chief Powell presented the August patrol and performance statistics for the Brenham Police Department. Powell gave an update on the success of the newly implemented HEAT (Highway Enforcement and Traffic) Unit. The Unit consists of a shift of officers that will target a specific area running traffic. The target location will change each time the Unit is deployed.

### 6. Administrative Updates

Chief Powell updated the committee on the most recent staff changes/updates:

Promotions: Lt. Steven Eilert and Sgt. Tiffany Anderson

Retirement: Sgt. Seth Klehm

Resignation: Cpl. Connor Caskey (moved out of town to be closer to family)

Lt. Raven stated that recruiting is going strong. October 16<sup>th</sup> there will be interviews (non-sworn) of potential candidates to send to the Bryan Police Academy and TEEX Academy. The goal is to be fully staffed in one year. Asst. Chief Schoen announced that the department now has seven drone operators; seven officers completed drone training; all tested and passed. BPD has been awarded a grant from FEMA and the Homeland Security Grant Program for the purchase of a Small Unmanned Aircraft System (SUAS) aka drone. Brenham Police Department will be the 1<sup>st</sup> department in the United States to have this drone, which includes an infrared sensing system and binocular vision.

Staff liaison Christi Korth announced the next CAB meeting will take place on December 10, 2024.
