The Nancy Carol Roberts Memorial Library opened its new facility doors to the public on November 14, 2016 and welcomed over 600 visitors the afternoon of the Grand Opening. The library has experienced a large increase in the number of visitors to the library, the number of new library cards issued and the number of computers reserved for use daily. As a result, circulation numbers have doubled and staff is in need of time to conduct monthly training, staff meetings, and general office/work tasks. We are proposing a monthly staff work day in which the library is closed to the public on the first Friday of every month. Statistics from the library's first 3 months in the new facility are attached.

The increased space in our new facility has allowed the library to expand programming offered to all ages. New programs include:

- Tuesday's with Lou-Lou: Interactive afterschool storytime every Tuesday at 4 p.m.
- Homework Hub: Free printing, chromebooks/laptops for checkout & homework assistance from NHS volunteers

- Teen Night- a teen activity on the last Monday of every month
- Healthy, Wealthy & Wise Series: something different every Wednesday evening at 5:30

- Basic American Sign Language Class- offered every other Tuesday at 5:30pm.



We plan to expand our programming even further as we aim to meet the educational and recreational needs of the community we serve. Some of our upcoming programs include:


