2. Citizen/Visitor Comments

- **a. Design-** Elizabeth Price reported on Holiday prep update. There are 20 new lighted wreaths for new locations off the main square. We are working with the High School art department on art wraps for transformers.
- **b. Economic Vitality-** Lowel Ogle reported the EEIG Program no applications in the pipeline and the program is on hold. Looking into possible solar-powered lighting for green parking lot.
- **c. Organization-** Tiffany Morisak reported the Main Street Christmas party will be on Thursday, December 7th at 6pm at Green Grain Events. The 25th Main Street Brenham celebration will be on Thursday, April 11, 2024 at The Barnhill Center.
